Autumn 1 a	<p>Say and use the number names in order in familiar contexts. Count reliably up to 10 everyday objects. Recognise numerals 1 to 9. Use language such as more or less, greater or smaller, heavier or lighter, to compare two numbers or quantities. In practical activities and discussion, begin to use the vocabulary involved in adding and subtracting. Find one more or one less than a number from 1 to 10. Begin to relate addition to combining two groups of objects, and subtraction to 'taking away'. Talk about, recognise and recreate simple patterns. Use language such as circle or bigger to describe the shape and size of solids and flat shapes. Use everyday words to describe position.
