

THE SCHOOL'S GOVERNANCE STRUCTURE

The St George's School Association is a non-profit making organisation whose Board is made up of current and former parents of the school, and also includes two members of the school's Staff Association as the Association's statute also provides for non parent Board nominations. The Chair of the Board of the Association (the Board of Governors) is Mr Gerard O'Donoghue.

The Association owns the building and land at La Storta and is the sole shareholder of the St George's School srl, a limited liability company in Italy entrusted with the running of the St George's British International School. The Board of the St George's School srl (SRL Board) is today made up of four parent-Governors and the Principal (who is also the school's Managing Director). The Chair of the SRL Board is Ms Helena Lundgren Doyle.

The St George's School srl, in turn, is the sole shareholder of the Italian limited liability company, Piccolo Mondo Scuola Materna e Elementare srl, that runs St George's Nomentana whose Board is made up of the same individuals who form the SRL Board.

The Association also has a Board of Trustees which is currently made up of long-standing Board members. The Board acts as *watchdogs* of the Association and act as arbitrators (should the need arise) and has the right to veto key policies and decisions. Its Chair is Peter W. Lloyd.

Board memberships are purely voluntary.
